From the Archery Captain & Thrown Weapons Marshal

Archers and throwers to the Line!

We have reached the dark half of the year, and have said good-bye to outdoor weeknight practices until spring But, that makes our Sunday practices all the sweeter.

Archery Practices will be held on Sundays at 10 am, alternating between Menomonee Park (W220 N7884 Town Line Rd, Menomonee Falls- \$6/car entrance fee) and Kinnickinnic River Parkway (2100 W Kinnickinnic River Pkwy, Milwaukee, WI 53215). Practices at Menomonee will be on October 3rd, 17th, and 31st. Practices at KK will be on October 10th and 24th. Thrown weapons practice will be on Sundays when we're at KK, we will also have thrown weapons practice at 12 pm, after archery practice.

Sadly, the ongoing plague forced the Barony of Windhaven to postpone Missile Mayhem II until 2022. We are planning on hosting our fellow archers from Jararvellir for a joint practice during our October 3rd practice at Menomonee Park.

Congratulations to Rhys ap Ishmael Llygad Odd and Karl Friedrich from Dinklesbuhl, the barony's new archery and thrown weapons champions. The archery tournament was loads of fun. Rhys and Arnbjørn tied for first in the royal round. Moira nic Connell and Tanja of Caer Anterth Mawr tied for second, and Karl placed third. For the disappearing ring shoot, first, second, and third places were Arnbjørn, Tanja, and Rhys. The personal highlight was the scale shoot, in which pairs of archers shoot at jugs filled with water, seeking to puncture them and drain the water before your

opponent can. The finals were between Rhys and Arnbjørn, with Rhys striking a successful blow through, low on the jug. Moira finished third. The thrown weapons tournament came down to a tie-breaker between Karl and Tanja.



A special thank you to The Hon. Lord Ronin the Bowleg, the kingdom deputy earl marshal for thrown weapons, going coming down to help me complete signature gatherings for the MiT process. He also took Jeff, a new archer, under his wing. I am hoping to report next month that I am a warranted TW marshal.

Additional Requirements for Northshield in-person activities (after September 1, 2021):

With concern over rising COVID-19 rates, especially the Delta strain, masks or face shields that fully cover your face will be required at all official Northshield in-person gatherings of any size or type (practices, meetings, events).

Effective September 1, all attendees over the age of 4, including fully vaccinated individuals, will be required to be masked at all times, except for fully vaccinated individuals actively engaged in (wearing a helmet or mask) combat activities (rapier and armoured) outdoors.

At outdoor activities, masks that fully cover the mouth and nose must be worn by all attendees over the age of 4 at all times except for eating, and drinking. The mask must be worn properly over the nose and mouth and be recognizable as an effective mask. The one exception is that fully vaccinated individuals may choose to remove their mask while actively engaged in combat activities. Masks must be put on immediately when leaving the field. If an individual is not fully vaccinated they are still required to wear a face mask when actively engaged in combat activities.

At indoor activities, masks will be required for all attendees over the age of 4, at all times including when engaged in combat activities. The mask may be removed briefly for eating and drinking while socially distanced.




